DRESS

Grand Chapter Officers and The Order of The High Priesthood (Elected) Officers may wear their appropriate robes. PGHPs may wear Red Coats and Black Pants. Appropriate Regalia will also be worn. Companions who have purchased the Grand Chapter Gold Shirt may wear this shirt and black pants in lieu of the traditional Royal Arch Dress during the Grand Convocation.

WORKS COMMITTEE
